This is the vaccine schedule for the first two years of life. Unless there is a documented medical reason for an exception, we expect all required vaccines to be given by the completion of the 2-year-old annual physical. All vaccines are required except for the Influenza Vaccine (FLU).

*The FLU vaccine is a seasonal vaccine.

Pediarix is a combination vaccination that includes:	Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetnus, Hepatitis B and Polio HIB: Haemophilus Influenzae Type b
PCV 13	Pneumococcal Conjugate
Rotateq	Rotavirus Vaccine
HEP A	Hepatitis A
MMR:	Measles mumps and rubeolla combination vaccine
HIB	Haemophilus Influenzae Type b
